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# DESIGN INSPIRATION INNOVATION.

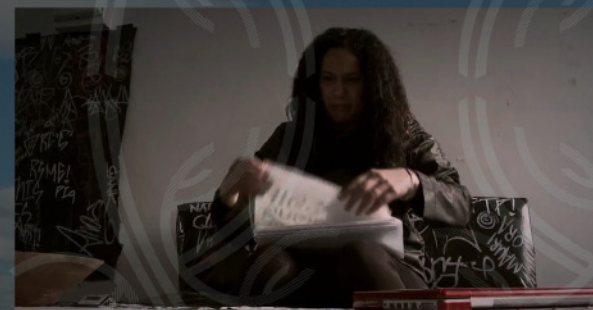
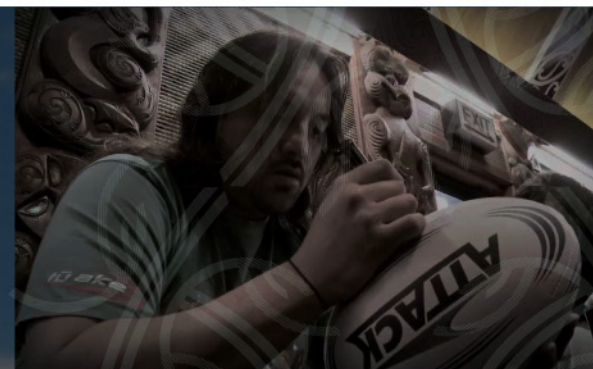
Nga Aho Annual General Hui is an opportunity
